1. Brigade Order No 89 is hereby cancelled, and Order No 90 is substituted.
2. The 11th Bn., East Lancashire R. will carry out a raid on the night of 17th/18th November, 1916, for the purpose of securing identification. Point of entry will be K.25.b.6.0.
3. The Raiding Party will consist of 1 Officer, 55 other ranks. Each flank will be protected by covering parties of at least 20 other ranks and 1 Lewis Gun, with an officer to command the two flanking parties.
4. There will be three bursts of Artillery fire at the enemy front line & wire, from K.17.b.1.7, to opposite JOHN COPSE. These bursts will take place at 6.30 p.m., 8.0 p.m., and 9 p.m., each burst lasting for 45 seconds. The patrol will enter the enemy trench immediately after the last burst.
5. The Artillery will, after the last burst, form a Pocket round the point of entry, which will be maintained for half an hour.
6. Matches will be synchronised at the Divisional Artillery H.Q., J.18.c.5.2., at 3.0 p.m. tomorrow, 17th Nov. O.C., 11th East Lancs R. will send a representative.
